Friends of The Veteran Corps 69th Regiment

Friends of The Veteran Corps 69th Regiment is the former Auxiliary of the Veteran Corps. The Corps recognizes the commitment of people who are not eligible for membership in the Corps but are deemed as both honorable and valuable to the Corps.

The Board will consider the following persons for Friends membership:

- 1. Spouses and children of a present or former member of the Corps.
- 2. Unaffiliated individuals who have demonstrated a clear commitment to the Corps, financially or otherwise. Such individuals shall be granted membership to the Friends of the Veteran Corps 69th Regiment by a unanimous vote of the Board.

Friends of the Veteran Corps 69th Regiment may participate in activities approved by the Board such as the Makin Island Remembrance Dinner, the Commander's Reception, the Saint Patrick's Day Parade and Reception, the Memorial Day Ceremony and any other activities approved by the Board.



Fundraising Update:

The CSM Thomas J. Fitzsimmons Educational Assistance Scholarship Program

When the Battalion deployed to Iraq in 2004, the 69th Regiment Veterans Corps, with CSM Thomas J. Fitzsimmons as the Commander, initiated a Family Support Fund. The purpose of this Fund was to assist the soldiers of the Battalion and their families during their deployment. An SOP governs how the Fund's assets are to be used. The SOP was amended in 2017/2018 to provide funding for Educational Assistance Awards to soldiers of the Battalion and soldiers of attached units. These awards were initiated by CSM Fitzsimmons and are now called the CSM Thomas J. Fitzsimmons Educational Assistance Scholarships. Soldiers of the Battalion and attached units who apply for the Scholarships must be enrolled in a post-secondary

undergraduate degree granting program at an institution of higher learning (2-year or 4-year college) or a non-degree granting post-secondary school (trade or technical school) or other post-secondary program licensed by New York State. The Veteran Corps initially offered five \$2,000 Scholarships and this year the Veteran Corps along with the 69th Regimental Headquarters are offering eight \$5,000 scholarships. These awards are traditionally presented at the Awards Ceremony on St. Patrick's Day.

The funding for these scholarships comes from donations from members of the Veteran Corps and members of the 69th Regimental Headquarters, their friends, religious and fraternal groups and business and corporate organizations.
