





<u>Membership Dues – 2024 Fee Structure</u>

Annual Membership Dues = \$20.00 - NEW DUES SCHEDULE

Effective <u>January 1, 2024</u> annual dues of twenty (\$20) will be for all new and current members of the Corps. Lifetime Membership is also available <u>(Effective June 1, 2023)</u> according to the following Lifetime Dues chart:

35 years of age or younger = \$500.00	51 to 64 years of age = \$300.00
36 to 50 years of age = \$400.00	Over 65 years of age = \$ 200.00

Members will become eligible for Lifetime Membership after two (2) consecutive years of membership in the Corps.
